

Day 1 Depart the USA Begin your thrilling journey as you depart from the USA on an overnight flight to the enchanting city of Paris, France. Enjoy meals & beverages onboard.

Day 2 Arrive in Paris, France - Caen - City Tour Welcome to the captivating "City of Light," Paris. Upon clearing customs & immigration, your tour director will warmly greet you as your adventure begins. Along the way to the magnificent city of Caen, your home base, for the next four magical nights you will enjoy an insightful panoramic Caen city tour, exploring the rich history & heritage of Normandy's capital. See the Castle of William the Conqueror, the Church of St-Pierre & more. Onwards you check into your hotel. Relax & enjoy an included dinner at your hotel, savoring French culinary delights. (D)

Day 3 Caen - Normandy D-Day Tour - Caen Enjoy breakfast at your hotel before embarking on a full-day tour with your tour escort & specialized Battlefield Guide to the hallowed grounds of the Normandy D-Day sites. Immerse yourself in history as you explore the Arromanches clifftops & observe the British military artifacts showcased in the Caen Mémorial collection. Pay your respects at The Normandy American Cemetery & reflect at the Walls of the Missing. Continue to the Omaha Beach Memorial Museum, a poignant tribute to the young men who made the ultimate sacrifice during the American naval landing. (B)

Day 4 Caen - Calvados Christian Drouin Distillery - Honfleur - Camembert - Caen Begin your day with a Calvados Christian Drouin Distillery tour. This distillery is nestled within half-timbered 17th century buildings in the heart of the Pays d'Auge. Here, you sample its world-famous brandy. Next, tour Honfleur, a beautiful coastal town on the estuary where the Seine River meets the English Channel. See its old harbor, lined with 16th to 18th century townhouses, the subject for artists including Claude Monet & native son Eugène Boudin. Then see the 15th-century St. Catherine's Church, a vaulted timber structure erected by shipbuilders. After some free time for lunch, you drive through the rolling hills of Normandy to Camembert. The village of Camembert is a storybook escape & the birthplace of its iconic cheese. Stroll through quaint streets lined with traditional cottages & let the aroma of cheese guide you to a local fromagerie. Here, indulge in a creamy, traditional Camembert tasting as cheesemakers share their passion & stories. Camembert offers a feast for the senses—a slice of French rural life you'll never forget. Conclude the day with a delightful dinner back in Caen. (B,D)

Day 5 Caen Enjoy an independent day to explore or take an optional excursion to the breathtaking Mont St. Michel, one of France's most iconic landmarks. As you approach this tidal island, you'll be captivated by its towering spires & medieval walls

rising dramatically from the sea. A UNESCO World Heritage Site, Mont St. Michel is a masterpiece of architecture & history. Wander its narrow, cobblestone streets lined with charming shops & cafes & ascend to the awe-inspiring Benedictine abbey perched at its peak. Here, marvel at the intricate details of its design & enjoy panoramic views of the bay, where the tides famously sweep in & out. (B)

Day 6 Caen - Reims After breakfast at your hotel, bid farewell to Caen & transfer to the splendid city of Reims. Stop in the historic town of Rouen, renowned for its half-timbered buildings & breathtaking gothic cathedral. Continue your journey to Reims, nestled in the spectacular Champagne region. (B)

Begin with visiting the Palace of Tau, a UNESCO World Heritage Site & former residence of French monarchs & the Archbishop of Reims.
